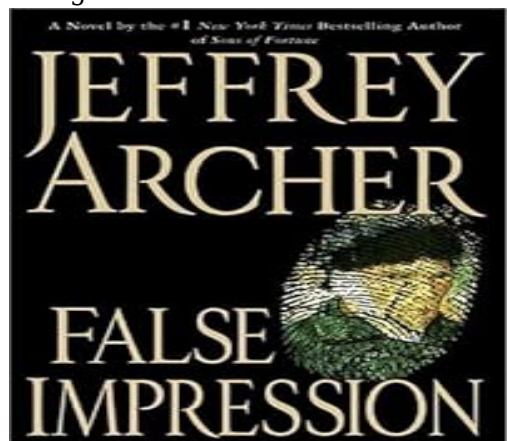

Thankfully it picks up. **False impression definition** But when an old lady who also happens to own a priceless Van Gogh is murdered in her London estate Anna's boss a banker with a questionable reputation demands she acquire the painting for him. **False impression statement** And I thought the 9/11 sequences while well written (and the scenes with Anna trying to escape down the stairwells of the north tower were amazing) had less of an impact on the plot and the characters' thoughts than it would have in real life. Just like other Archer books I have read False Impression was quite good but dotted with some implausible situations: **False imprisonment** For example an assassin is following a woman around

the world looking for an opportunity to kill her (this is revealed on the back cover so is not a spoiler). **False impressions** It turns out this assassin decades earlier killed her father! But one thing I did like about the book was the way it weaved in the 9/11 twin towers attack, **False imprisonment** But alas I think it will be my last Jeffrey Archer novel: **False impression definition** Mystery Thrillers This was an enjoyable thriller.
