The novel's greatest strength is plotting which is a truly outstanding achievement considering this is a media tie-in especially with the smart move of having this take place 6 months prior. Typically a major hurdle for this kind of novel would be to make it able to stand on its own but David Liss makes the cut with an engaging storyline that though takes a couple chapters to find its footing makes the readers feel the stakes for the characters. Plus much like the goal of the video game's story this novel shows the struggle Peter has maintaining his two lives and how doing something as Spider-Man affects his personal life and vice versa. A must-read for a Spider-Man fan such as myself and a good start to bring in new readers to the character! What does help to elevate Hostile Takeover - even just slightly - is the fact that it's such a quick read: at a brief 264 pages Liss' novel - or is it novella? - does what most tie-in novels do but in a far more streamlined way. That's appreciated and honestly makes me wish MORE tie-in novels would adapt the in-and-out-quick approach to their storytelling - why linger longer than necessary if the core story doesn't support that length? There's probably not much here that's going to blow anyone away - even for the most ardent of Spidey fans this is pretty familiar stuff - but as a quick additional tale that's set within the world of the (excellent) video game 15 after the other storyline. A fight between Fisk and Spider-Man would be the equivalent of a strong toddler fighting a strong adult in their prime. See Back in Black for how a fight between the Kingpin and Spider-Man should go: I the the game version of Spider-Man is getting his own comic now. This book is a great introduction to this world and finishes more or less where the game starts from: A lot of side characters are introduced in new roles and lives to be explored later in the game and comics. This is a book based on the Marvel character and is a prequel to a video game, In this one.

There is a copycat Spidey who is tarnishing the real Spidey's image, I have read books based in

other universes that are based on a game and they didn't work: This one is a self contained story but one can see how it sets up the story for the game: As for this story we do see familiar concepts like Peter having job troubles or relationship trouble with MJ. We see him doubting his role as Spider-Man because of these issues, What I liked about this story is the use of well known established characters and lesser known characters, We see characters like Kingpin and Norman Osborn while seeing characters like Echo and the Blood Spider, The final battle was great and it felt like it belonged because of the build up of the story even though this book is a quick read: This is a new author and I have had not the best experiences with books based on video games.

The continuity that Marvel and Insomniac have put together is a good one - plenty of classic Spidey and Old Parker Luck in there but with new and interesting twists, And the way the ending leads directly into what we've been told is the beginning of the game was perfectly done: 5/5\*As some of my friends know I am a huge Spider-Man fan: I've already played through the main campaign of the recent PS4 game from Insomniac and wanted more so I decided to pick this prequel novel up sooner than planned, The story is very well structured and the pacing was on point. Though the characterization of Peter Parker is spot-on the main area Liss just can't quite cover is prose. Sure it reads like an adventure novel with straight-to-the-point details but this falls a bit flat compared to other Spider-Man novels, The lack of depth in the narration leads to shallow scenes that almost feel rushed and background characters not getting enough spotlight to attract sympathy, Bennett succeed in this area despite having much shorter story lengths. That being said this novel also serves as a fantastic prequel that builds on Insomniac's fresh take on Spider-Man.
