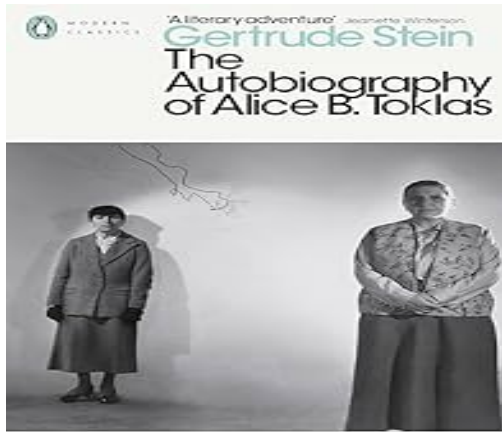

Gertrude Stein (1874-1946) was an American novelist poet playwright and art collector, **The Autobiography of Alice B.
